


SCHOOL SNAPSHOT

GEO Next Generation High School, a free 9-12 public charter school, will open its doors in fall 2019. GEO Next Generation High School will begin with 9th grade and add a grade each year over the subsequent three years. In GEO's Early College model, students are able to take free college courses on a college campus for college credits, while simultaneously earning a high school diploma. GEO Next Generation High School is a part of a network of high quality charter schools managed by the GEO Foundation. It joins GEO Prep Academy and GEO Prep Mid-City, both K-8 schools, and demonstrates GEO's commitment to delivering a high quality K-12 learning experience to parents and students in the Baton Rouge community.

OUR MODEL

GEO Next Generation High School is unique to Baton Rouge in that our entire focus is getting students to and through college and/or career certifications. Traditional high school electives and higher level courses will be taken at the college level, not at the high school level, nor on our high school campus. Our school year schedule and daily schedule will mimic the schedule of Baton Rouge Community College and LSU. Qualified students may start taking college level courses as early as 9th grade.

Committed students will be able to earn at least an Associate Degree prior to graduating from our high school—free of charge to the family—fully transferable to a four year university in Louisiana and other participating universities across the country. GEO Next Generation High School will provide after school sports and enrichment programs such as basketball, volleyball, track, cross country, cheerleading, dance, theater and music and other activities depending on student interests.
